• Shawn Loper - Bel Air Town Run Update

- Registration is up significantly from this time last year. Currently, 501 registered with goal of 1,200 total participants
- Several sponsors including Bel Air Athletic Club, Jones Junction, Gold Medal PT, Bike Doctor, Wegmans, Panera Bread,
 Saxons, and the Presenting Sponsor St. James Academy.
- Volunteers are still need for road guards, packet pickup, and clean up.

2020 will be the 40th anniversary of the town run.

• Tim Gavin - HAT Run Update

- o Another successful year. 497 runners registered, 419 raced.
- The race re-route had good reviews
- o The tentative date for next year is March 21,2020
- o Registration will open on November 29th

• Phil Anderson Survivor Run Update

- After 12 years as Race Director, Phil will be stepping down as the Survivor Run race director.
- Over the 12 years of the races history, Phil has handed out 70 pairs of New Balance shoes, 2,700 New Balance shirts and raised a total of \$35,546 for six different organizations.
- We will need to decide to seek a new race director.

Committee/Additional Board Updates

Membership – Susan Kemen

- We are currently at 526 members for the year, this is up from 387 in Dec 2018.
- o Goal is to reach 800 members by 2023.
- Create fliers to insert into race bags at area races. Susan to reach out to Harford Tech to get the cost of designing and printing fliers.
